Water System Operator

Ward Six Water Association of Rapides Parish is an Equal Opportunity Provider and Employer seeking to hire a full time water treatment operator. The position requires the operator to work a regular work week, with possible nights, weekends, and holidays as needed in emergency situations.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Ensure operational compliance with Louisiana Department of Health and Federal EPA water quality standards
- Maintain and monitor production, treatment, and distribution of a public water system in accordance with Louisiana Department of Health
- Maintain required State records and reports
- Maintain wells and well sites
- Operate equipment and follow OSHA regulations
- System wide meter reading and flushing
- Install, test, lock and unlock, and remove meters as needed; tap water main as needed
- Repair all water leaks and system tests
- Maintain inventory of materials, supplies, and equipment needed
- Available to respond to emergency conditions

Minimum Requirements:

- High school diploma or High school equivalency.
- Must be able to pass the written certification exam to become certified operator within one year time frame and maintain proper certification as required by the State of Louisiana to produce water, operate systems, and distribute water to system users.
- Ability to read water system maps to locate water lines, valves, and flush locations.
- Must possess a valid driver's license.
- Must be able to pass a drug screen.

Desired Requirements:

- Two (2) years experience in water distribution or treatment; or any equivalent combination of education, training, and experience which provides the requisite knowledge, skills, and abilities for this job.
- Operator certification by the State of Louisiana to produce water, operate systems, and distribute water to system users.

Compensation:

- Salary will be dependent upon relevant experience and education.
